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Styliani Tziaferi was born in Thessaloniki in 1974. She graduated from Faculty of Nursing, University of Athens (UOA) and she owns postgraduate degrees (MSc) in “Health and Safety in Work” from Faculty of Medicine, UOA, in 1999 and in “Public Health” from Faculty of Nursing, UOA, in 2000. She owns the degree of School of Pedagogical and Technological Education (ASPETE) in 2002, the certificate of the three year program of European Academy of Nursing Science (EANS) in 2005 and degrees of three foreign languages. Her PhD thesis in the subject area of Occupational Health from the Faculty of Nursing, UOA, in 2006 has the title “Risk assessment of occupational hazards in hospital sector”. Since 1999 she has worked as a clinical nurse in Intensive Care Unit of General Hospital of Athens “Evangelismos”. Since 2002 she has worked in Public, Special, Eye Hospital “Ophthalmiatreio of Athens”, assigned with community nursing duties, in Emergency Unit and Outpatient clinic wards, since 2006 in Office of Hospital Administration and of Nursing Administration with responsibilities of Hospital Infections, of Health, Safety and Quality, & Public Health issues in the hospital. Since 2000 she has taught “Health & Safety” in Nursing Specialty in General Hospital of Athens “Sismanoglion” and in Public Centers of Continuous Education of Health Professionals in Public Hospitals. Since 2003-2008 she taught “Health and safety in the workplace” in Military School of Nursing of Greek Ministry of Defense. Since 1998–today she has collaborated with the Faculty of Nursing, UOA and since 2005 until 2012, she collaborated as a Lecturer with contract (L.407/80) with Faculty of Nursing in University of Peloponnese referring to Public Health issues, especially in “Community Nursing” and “Health and Safety in the workplace”. Since 2008-2011 she collaborated as a special scientist in Technological University of Cyprus in the organization and teaching of “Community and Transcultural Nursing” during the upgrade development at University level, official Program of Nursing education in Cyprus. In November of 2009 she was elected as a Lecturer in Faculty of Nursing of University of Peloponnese, in “Community Nursing”, where she teaches in undergraduate and postgraduate level: “Community Nursing”, “Health and safety in the Workplace”, “Transcultural Nursing”, “Home Nursing”, “Travelers’ Health”. In February 2012 she continued, officially, her tenure in the grade of Lecturer in the Department of Nursing, University of Peloponnese, at the subject area: “Community Nursing” adding also the topic: “Research Methodology” (2016-today), the responsibility of one obligatory course at postgraduate level till today (2013-2019) where she has also taught, titled: “Political and institutional factors in crisis management”, one obligatory course at postgraduate level titled: “Special issues of Management in Risk, Safety and Accessibility for People with Disability”, in the Department of Sports Management in University of Peloponnese (2018-2019, 2019-2020) and participated in 2 courses of the post graduate level degree titled: “Crisis Management & Massive catastrophe, Public Health Nursing” in National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Dep. of Nursing (2018-2021). She

has been invited also in European Nursing Universities for teaching in the field of “Community Nursing” & “Occupational Health” and in terms of Erasmus’ exchange for academic staff, as well, being, herself, the academic coordinator in Erasmus bilateral agreements between the University of Peloponnese and six (6) Nursing University departments [in Norway (The Arctic University of Norway-UiT), in Spain (University of Lleida, Universidad Autonoma de Madrid, Universidad Complutense de Madrid), in Denmark (VIA University College), in Italy (University of Cagliari)]. In March 2013 she was upgraded to an Assistant Professor at the subject area: “Community Nursing”. In July 2017 she was evaluated by an academic committee (following Greek law for academics) and she obtained the permanent position into the level of Assistant Professor in the specialty of “Community Nursing” in the Department of Nursing, University of Peloponnese, in August 2020 she promoted herself into the next level for academics (position of Associate Professor in Community Nursing and Occupational health Nursing-COHN). She has also, been assigned until today, administrative duties as a member of numerous administrative and scientific committees in the department of Nursing in the University of Peloponnese. She is also a supervisor of five (5) PhD students in the field of “COHN”, adding 3 more, already finished their PhD. Also, fifteen (15) postgraduate students (master level) have completed their thesis and six (6) are still running, in the field of “COHN” as well, under her supervision from 2013 till today. She is the Academic Coordinator for the University of Peloponnese which is a partner in the consortium of the ERASMUS+ KA203 Project DeMoPHaC: “Development of a model for nurses’ role in inter-professional pharmaceutical care” (2018-2021, <https://ec.europa.eu/programmes/erasmusplus/projects/eplus-project-details/#project/2018-1-BE02-KA203-046861>). Since 1998 she has participated as a proponent, coordinator and invited speaker in an adequate number of international, European and Greek conferences, with announcements mainly in the area of “COHN”, as a reviewer of scientific papers in Greek and European congresses and in the two Nursing Greek peer review Journals and in international scientific journals [for ex. 1. “Health and Social Care in the Community” 2. “Public Health Nursing”, 3. “Journal of Nursing Care Quality”, 4. International Journal of Occupational Health & Public Health Nursing (IJOHPHN, being the Chief Editor of it, as well)]. In the mean time, her research and writing activity refers to Public Health issues, whereas she has distinguished with an international, academic award in the field of Occupational Health from the Occupational Safety & Health Institute in Korea and Korea Occupational Safety (OSHRI) & Health Agency (KOSHA). She published in Greek (2018) (translation and scientific editing) the book: “Complex interventions in Health, An overview of research methods” written by Prof D.A. Richards and Prof I.R. Hallberg, structured around the influential UK Medical Research Council guidance for use of complex interventions research methods in Health. She is a member of scientific groups in Nursing research programs in Greece and in Europe, in scientific and professional NGOs and Committees/Societies in Europe (in EANS, REFLECTION NETWORK, FOHNEU, ACENDIO) and Internationally [(ICOH: SCOHN, SCAP, EPROH), ICONS, GNPHN]. More analytically, she is a member of nursing scientific and professional associations in Greece [Hellenic Nurses Association (HNA), UNG, CNS and especially the elected President of Sector of “Primary Health Care and Community Nursing” of HNA (2008-2012, 2012-2016, 2016-2019)]. She is an appointed, academic member in the Governmental Committee of Greek Ministries of Education and Health for the current Development of Nursing Education & of Health Professionals and especially in Primary Health Sector in Greece (2018-2023), an elected member of the Board of European Academy in Nursing Science-(EANS, 2014-2017 & 2018-2021, [www.european-academy-of-nursing-science.com](http://www.european-academy-of-nursing-science.com)) and in the Board of the Federation of Occupational Health Nurses in the

European Union (FOHNEU, [www.fohneu.org](http://www.fohneu.org)) being its President for 2013-2016, as well. Recently, she has been appointed, also, as the National Secretary of Greece in the International Commission on Occupational Health (ICOH) for the Triennium 2018-2021 (<http://www.ichweb.org/site/national-secretaries3.asp#ancora>). She is appointed also from WHO-Regional Office in Greece, as one of the two Greek Academic Advisers for the development of the Curriculum for Postgraduate Specialization in Community Nursing in Greece in 2018-2019, which is under publication by WHO.
